Notice to Skippers no. 49/2022

Pursuant to Art. 14 section (1)(4) of the Act of 20 July 2017 - Water Law (Journal of Laws 2020, item 310, 284, 695, 782, 875) and Art. 43 section (6) of the Act of 21 December 2000 on inland navigation (Journal of Laws of 2019, item 1568, 1901, 2170, of 2020 item 284.) The Regional Water Management Board in Szczecin, in agreement with the Oder-Havel Waterway and Shipping Authority in Eberswalde and in agreement with the Inland Waterway Authority in Szczecin, informs that due to the disappearance of ice phenomena and the partial display of floating and land-based navigation markings

as of December 27, 2022 from 07:00 am, the following sections of the ODER RIVER ARE OPENED FOR NAVIGATION during THE DAYTIME:

- **the Oder river from km 581.00 (town of Świecko) to 585.70 (town of Słubice) at the following transit depth on December 28, 2022: water level gauge Słubice: 196 cm - transit depth: 181 cm;**
- **the Oder river from km 612.00 (town of Kietz) to 614.70 (200 m above the road bridge) with the following transit depth on December 28, 2022: water level gauge Kostrzyn (the Oder): 217 cm - transit depth: 127 cm;**

The above transit depths will change in the face of fluctuating water levels. Please follow the current water levels at the water gauges: Słubice and Kostrzyn (the Oder) on the official IMGW website - <https://hydro.imgw.pl/#map/19.5.51.5.7.true.false.false.true.false.false.->

In the following days, the waterway administration will proceed to open further sections of the waterway for navigation.
