Notice to Skippers No. 39/2022

Pursuant to Art. 43 point 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on inland navigation (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2022, item 1097.), State Water Holding "Polish Waters" Regional Water Management Board in Szczecin, in coordination with the Inland Navigation Office in Szczecin hereby informs that in connection with the winter season when ice phenomena are expected to occur, the waterway administration <u>shall commence the reduction of navigation signs on Lake Dabie as of 28 November 2022, as follows</u>:

- complete removal of floating signs from the side arms of Lake Dąbie (i.a. waterways leading to Lubczyna, crossover to Lake Dąbie "Małe" and from the waterway on Lake Dąbie "Małe");

- reduction of signs on the main waterway of Lake Dąbie.

As a result, the navigation signs on Lake Dąbie will not meet the requirements for night navigation and will not comply with the requirements specified in Art. 25 of the ordinance of the Director of the Inland Navigation Office in Szczecin on 17 February 2020 on detailed terms and conditions for the safety of traffic and berthing of ships (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2019, item 1568), which **regulates the rules of night navigation**.

In the region of Lake Dabie, only daytime navigation will be possible.

In the event of the development of ice phenomena, closures of navigation on the lower and border sections of the Oder River should be taken into account.
