

Notice to Skippers no. 15/2023

Pursuant to Article 14 1(4) of the Act of July 20, 2017 – Water Law (Journal of Laws of 2022, item 1549) and Article 43 (6) of the Act of December 21, 2000 on inland navigation (Journal of Laws of 2022, item 1097) The Regional Water Management Board in Szczecin, in agreement with the Inland Waterway Authority in Szczecin and in agreement with the Waterways and Shipping Authority Oder Havel in Eberswalde, informs that as of April 13, 2023, the signage displayed on the border section:

- of the Oder River from km 542.4 (mouth of the Nysa Łużycka) to km 704.1 (weir in Widuchowa),
- of West Oder River from km 0.0 (weir in Widuchowa) to km 17.1 (state border),

<u>complies with the requirements set out</u> in §7 of Order 1/2022 of the Director of the Inland Waterway Authority in Szczecin of March 10, 2022 on shipping on border waters of the Oder, Western Oder and Nysa Łużycka rivers (Official Journal of the West Pomeranian Province, Szczecin, March 11, 2022; Official Journal of the Lubuskie Province, Gorzów Wielkopolski, March 10, 2022). In view of the above, we would like to inform you that the signs displayed in the above-mentioned sections <u>comply with the requirements governing night-time navigation</u>.

NOTE - exceptions include:

- railway bridge at km 580.7 of the Oder River (Świecko),
- railway bridge at km 653.9 of the Oder River (Siekierki),
- road bridge at km 662.3 of the Oder River (Osinów Dolny),

on which work is currently taking place to reinstate night-time navigation signage. The admission of the above sections of the waterway will be announced by a separate notice.
