

## Notice to Skippers no. 35/2023

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1(4) of the Act of July 20, 2017 – Water Law (Journal of Laws of 2023, item 1478, 1688, 1890, 1963, 2029) and Art. 43 sec. (6) of the Act of December 21, 2000 on inland navigation (Journal of Laws of 2022, item 1097, 2642 of 2023 item 1588, 2029.) The Regional Water Management Board in Szczecin, in agreement with the Inland Navigation Office in Szczecin, informs that due to the onset of cold weather and the current low water temperature, the first ice phenomena are likely to occur. Due to the above, the RWMB in Szczecin is proceeding with a complete reduction of navigation markings on Dąbie Lake and the Gartz-Marwice Canal on November 30, 2022.

As from November 30, 2023 SHIPPING SHALL BE CLOSED ON:

- DABIE LAKE (including side lanes),

## - GARTZ - MARWICE CANAL.

At the same time, we would like to inform you that vessels making a voyage during the formation of ice phenomena and navigation closures should proceed to the nearest port or other safe place outside the riverbed and vessels prepared for navigation should abandon the voyage. In addition, contractors of hydrotechnical works on the water in the event of ice phenomena should cease work.
