Notice to Skippers no. 1/2023

Pursuant to the art. 14 sec. 1 item 4 of the Water Resources Act of 20th July 2017 r. (Journal of Laws of 2020, items 310, 284, 695, 782, 875) and art. 43 sec. 6 of the Inland Shipping Act of 21st December 2000 (Journal of Laws of 2019, items 1568, 1901, 2170, and Journal of Laws of 2020 item 284.) the Regional Water Management Board, acting in agreement with the Oder-Havel Waterways and Shipping Office in Eberswalde and with the Inland Shipping Office in Szczecin, would like to inform that

since January 5, 2023 r. at 7:00 am, THE ODER RIVER IS BEING OPEN FOR THE DAYTIME WATERWAY TRAFFIC:

- **from 617.6 km (Warta estuary) to 667.2 km (Hohensaaten city)**
at the following transit depth on January 4, 2023:
Gozdowice water gauge: 316 cm – transit depth: 136 cm;
Kienitz water gauge: 311 cm - transit depth: 136 cm;
