Notice to Skippers no. 3/2023

Pursuant to the art. 14 sec. 1 item 4 of the Water Resources Act of 20th July 2017 (Journal of Laws of 2020, items 310, 284, 695, 782, 875) and art. 43 sec. 6 of the Inland Shipping Act of December 21, 2000 (Journal of Laws of 2019, items 1568, 1901, 2170, and Journal of Laws of 2020 item 284.) the Regional Water Management Board, acting in agreement with the Oder-Havel Waterways and Shipping Office in Eberswalde and with the Inland Shipping Office in Szczecin would like to inform that

since January 11, 2023 at 7:00 am, THE ODER RIVER IS BEING OPEN FOR THE WATERWAY DAYTIME TRAFFIC:

- **between 586.0 km (Słubice city) and 617.6 km (Warta estuary) at the following transit depth on January 11, 2023:**
Słubice water gauge: 202 cm – transit depth: 140 cm;
Frankfurt water gauge: 212 cm - transit depth: 140 cm;
