Notice to Skippers no. 4/2023

Pursuant to the art. 14 sec. 1 item 4 of the Water Resources Act of 20th July 2017 (Journal of Laws of 2020, items 310, 284, 695, 782, 875) and art. 43 sec. 6 of the Inland Shipping Act of December 21, 2000 (Journal of Laws of 2019, items 1568, 1901, 2170, and Journal of Laws of 2020 item 284.) the Regional Water Management Board, acting in agreement with the Oder-Havel Waterways and Shipping Office in Eberswalde and with the Inland Shipping Office in Szczecin, would like to inform that

since January 11, 2023 at 7:00 am, THE ODER RIVER IS BEING OPEN FOR THE WATERWAY DAYLIGHT TRAFFIC:

- **from 667.2 km (Hohensaaten city) to 704.1 km (Widuchowa weir)**
at the following transit depth on January 11, 2023:
Bielinek water gauge: 309 cm – transit depth: 181 cm;
Stuetzkow water gauge: 627 cm - transit depth: 181 cm;

Following the decision described above, since January 11, 2023, the entire section of the Oder running along the state border has been opened for daylight waterway traffic.
