

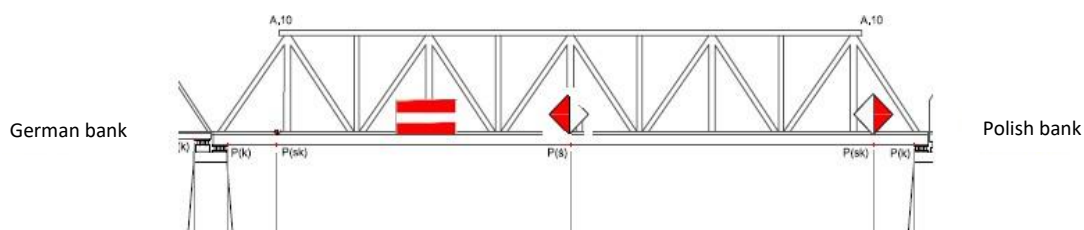

Notice to Skippers No. 16/2021

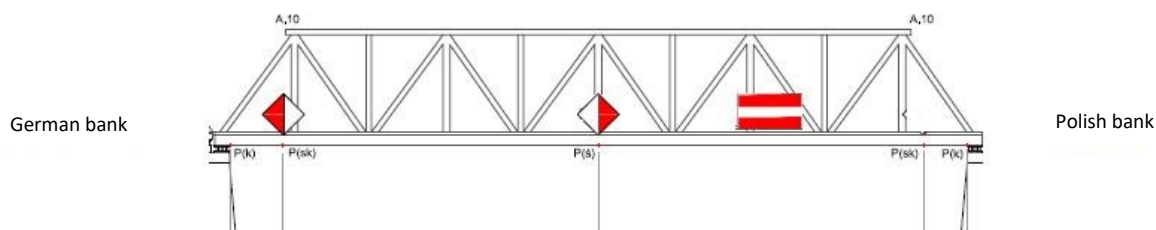
Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1(4) of the Act of 20 July 2017 – Water Law (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2020, item 310, 284, 695, 782, 875) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on Inland Navigation (Dz. U./Journal of Laws/ of 2019, item. 1568, 1901, 2170, and of 2020, item 284.), the Regional Water Management Board in Szczecin, in consultation with the Waterways and Shipping Office Oder-Havel and in agreement with the Office of Inland Navigation in Szczecin, hereby informs that:

- **From 6 April 2021 at km 653.9 of the Oder River, repair works will be carried out on the bridge in Siekierki, resulting in partial closure of the navigable span.**

In the first stage of the works, the navigable span will be closed to navigation on the side of the German shore. The width of the span after closing one half will be approximately 43m. The open part of the navigable span will not be limited in vertical clearance.



In the next stage, likewise, the span will be closed on the side of the Polish shore. The width of the span after closing one half will be approximately 43m. The open part of the navigable span will not be limited in vertical clearance.



The works will be marked in accordance with applicable regulations. We will announce the change
