

## Notice to Skippers no. 41/2022

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1 point 4 of the Act of 20 July 2017 – Water Law (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2020, item 310, 284, 695, 782, 875) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on inland navigation (Dz. U. /Journal Of Laws/ of 2019, item 1568, 1901, 2170 of 2020, item 284.), the Regional Water Management Board in Szczecin, in agreement with the Office of Inland Navigation in Szczecin, hereby informs that due to the forecasted cold wave and the current low water temperature, first ice phenomena are possible. In view of the above, the **Regional Water Management Board in Szczecin is proceeding with a complete reduction of navigation markings on Dąbie Lake on 7 December 2022.**

### **As of 7 December 2022, DĄBIE LAKE WILL BE CLOSED FOR NAVIGATION.**

Furthermore, we would like to remind you that the vessels operating during ice formation and navigation closures should proceed to the nearest port or another safe place outside the riverbed and the vessels not prepared for navigation should abandon the voyage. Also, contractors of hydro-engineering works on the water should stop working if icing occurs.
